ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	 Meeting 9 April 2024 Duke Orchard: A list of tasks to be completed before the opening on 27 April was agreed: wood chip around trees, grass cutting and strimming of paths, installation of sign and noticeboard, signage regarding no dogs, fencing and signs warning of drop, pedestrian gate installation, installation of benches with anchors, surfacing of picnic sites with wood chip. Much of this work will be completed on the next volunteer day on 20 April. Community Chest money to be spent on a metal arch for the pedestrian gate and some crab apple saplings to be installed on 20 April. Event on 27 April will include an official opening including two children, cider on arrival, Cargreen Village Choir, BioBlitz organised by Landulph Climate Group, Information about plans for Landulph Orchard Green with opportunity to volunteer and give feedback. Duchess Green: Work has been completed on an application for a second grant for FIPL from Marsh Farm of £48,924.42 General: Public liability insurance for use of LOG by members of the public is now included in the Parish Council insurance provided there is a risk assessment and maintenance plan in place.
