<b>ACTIVITIES TO REPORT</b>	<p>Video Conference with Stantec representing PeakGen (Battery storage, build, own and operators). Video conference held on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2023 at Parish Council Meeting. Those present/invited: Landulph Parish Councillors, members of the public, Julie Barrow: Stantec, Matt Marshall: PeakGen, Stuart Natkus (Stantec). George Laird (PeakGen): -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stantec provided a pre-application overview of the proposed PeakGen BESS development adjacent to Landulph National Grid Substation.</li> <li>• Cllr Gawith shared a sketch of all the proposed developments and called for Stantec/PeakGen to participate in a coordinated approach to site access, logistics and planning.</li> <li>• Cllr Worth indicated the expectation that PeakGen should make a financial contribution to the local community.</li> <li>• Cllr Ansell enquired if PeakGen were aware of the electricity export limitations at Landulph Substation due to power network congestion in the South West. PeakGen were unaware of this issue and will investigate.</li> </ul> <p>Email received from James Whiteford, National Grid Energy Systems Operator (NG ESO). Following the disappointment that NGESO would not be able provide representation to explain the purpose and benefits of the proposed BESS and Grid Stability developments, and an email to Julian Leslie (NG ESO Director), James Whiteford has emailed to confirm that they will after all be able to participate in a call with the Parish Council in the New Year.</p> <p>Cllr Ansell and Cllr Tagg attended a webinar presentation on Cornwall Council Electric Vehicle charging strategy. The presentation materials are marked "Information Classification: Controlled" and we were advised not for general circulation. A consultation survey is open until 14<sup>th</sup> January 2024: <a href="https://letstalk.cornwall.gov.uk/ev-infrastructure-strategy">https://letstalk.cornwall.gov.uk/ev-infrastructure-strategy</a>. The final strategy document will be signed off in Feb/March 2024.</p>
