ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	<p>9th January 2024 meeting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LCG COMMUNITY WINTER EVENTS • 5th February at LMH. Climate Matters: Reuse, Recycle, Reduce. LCG will be promoting this event through Parish email, noticeboard posters, Parish magazine and social media. 2 guest speakers confirmed: Cllr Carol Mould to explain Council's new waste management system and Rosie Walters (Saltash Scrapstore) to illustrate how to recycle items that are not appropriate for a Charity shop but too good to be thrown away. • 4th March. Climate Matters: Transport for All – Electric Vehicles, Buses and Footpaths. A representative from the Council will explain Cornwall's planned E.V. Infrastructure Strategy. Gemma Hall will promote how to make better use of our public transport network and LCG will publicise our footpaths, including reference to Botus/Carkeel footpath. • PUBLIC TRANSPORT. • The group wish to conduct a transport survey to coincide with the topics discussed in March's Climate Matters. • Landulph Public Rights of Way group to be promoted through social media and the Parish magazine. Informing residents of improvements made in the safety and accessibility of our footpaths. • NATURE RECOVERY. • A government strategy to revive remnants of temperate rainforest from Cornwall to Western Scotland has been announced. LCG have logged two local areas of interest. Further evidence is required and we are contacting National Landscape for advice. • RSPB Big Garden Birdwatch to be promoted during weekend of 26th-28th January. This is important citizen science and fosters a more wide-spread understanding of the birds in our area. • Small sign to be added to the copse on the outskirts of the cricket ground indicating that it is part of the Forest of Cornwall and planted by residents of the parish in 2021. • Daffodils and wildflower seeds have been planted on roadside verges around the Parish.
