ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	<p>Planting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> On 3 November, 19 volunteers planted over 1000 bulbs (mostly daffodils) including hundreds donated by Tony Channing Subsequently volunteers sowed the new bank by the pond with a mixed grass ley to stabilise it. <p>Cornwall Sustainability Award</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cllr Gregory has entered Duke Orchard in the Nature and Trees for Growth category. <p>Meeting 11 November 2024</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Agreed to request that £500 Community Chest offered by Cllr Worth be used to purchase a wildlife camera system. £18567.89 has now been claimed and paid from FIPL grant of £48924.84) Every child in Landulph School has now submitted a design for a 1 metre square of the Miyawaki forest which will be planted on the next planting day (17 November). Agreed a further planting day on 8 December. Agreed to cover boardwalk bridge a woo woo loo slope with wire mesh. Discussed budget and agreed to: ask for a variation from bulb budget to cover additional cost of rabbit protection for Miyawaki and hedging; buy some English bluebell bulbs from the bulb budget; use rolled 803 and sand for paths and consider rubber surface in the future. <p>Recorded visits to the Orchards in October, November</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> October 9, November 9 Woo woo loo is being used and is clean and with no smells
