ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	<p>Meeting 7 January 2025</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two claims being submitted for November and December, but although the variations have been agreed, the payments have not been approved yet (total £14217.33). • Tiered Green Meeting Space completed and Field Shelters/Bird Hides installed before Christmas. • Remaining route of paths agreed once field dries out. • Aim for trees to be planting before end January with assistance of Glyn and digger • Remaining bulbs ordered (100 snowdrops) • Agreed to purchase and install a split wooden gate (4ft pedestrian, 8ft vehicle with removeable centre post) at entrance with stone walling delayed awaiting new funding. • Weeding and mulching of trees in Duke Orchard has started with Duke of Edinburgh volunteer and will continue on the volunteer day on 26 January. On this day will plant remaining daffodil bulbs in the hedges and complete the entrance fence and sign. • Due to the wetness in Duchess Green, Wassail now planned for Duke Orchard on 26 January from 2:30. • Aim to keep a photographic record of Duchess Green from agreed points to show how it develops – Dominic Martyn, Environment Agency to advise. <p>Visits to Landulph Orchard Green</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ginnette Sutherland, Tamar Valley National Landscape Community Engagemnent Officer on 13 January. • Middle walk (approx. 30 people) of the Parish Walks on 27 December visited Duchess Green • Recorded visits to the Orchards in December 6, January 4
