ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	<p>Meeting 6 January 2025</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Four films proposed for March Film Week: Monday 10 March 2pm for 2:30pm: Six Inches of Soil (feature length film) Tuesday 11 March 7pm for 7:30pm: Wilding (feature length film) Wednesday 12 March 7pm for 7:30pm: Power to the People (from Cornwall Climate Care) Thursday 13 March 2pm for 2:30pm: Down the Drain (from Cornwall Climate Care) • Refreshments will be served with each film and we will encourage discussion on the issues raised. • Unfortunately, since the meeting we have discovered that we will have to pay a license fee to show each of these films (this has changed in the last year). The first two films will cost £275 to show, Cornwall Climate Care have said they will charge a small license fee for the last two films. • In previous winter talks we have asked for a donation to cover refreshment costs but we suggest this year that we charge £7 per film including refreshments. (We have £67 left from the donations received from last year's winter talks which will cover the costs of refreshments). • Gerald consolidated and submitted our response to the draft Cornwall Nature Recovery Strategy. Although overall we were a bit disappointed in the document, there is useful information in it for grant applications. • The group was also updated on the bus discussions and a report the landowner has received on Ziggerson Hill Woods <p>Meeting (13 January) with Ginnette Sutherland Amanda and Clare had a successful meeting with Ginnette, showing her Coombe Corner and discussing the work of the climate group. We have been invited to give a talk about LCG (and LOG) at the Tamar Valley Community Connections Spring Forum on 1 March.</p>
