REFERENDUM

The community of Landulph Parish decided to develop a Neighbourhood Plan in order to sustain the community for those who live and work here – for current and future generations.

What has happened so far

The plan started back in 2015 with a Public Consultation to seek Landulph parishioner's views on the plan.

Three separate meetings were held specifically for: local businesses; parishioners under 50; and parishioners over 50.

A Steering Group, made up from a cross-section of the parish was set up to establish a plan for the parish.

An Open Day was held at Landulph Memorial Hall in May 2016 to capture Landulph parishioner's comments.

A report was completed, together with a Housing Needs Survey.

A Traffic Survey was carried out in October / November 2016 to study volume and congestion.

In Autumn 2016 every house in the parish was asked to complete the survey, with a separate survey for young residents. A booklet was produced to accompany the survey.

Landulph Neighbourhood Plan was developed, then checked by Cornwall Council and an independent examiner.
