ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Ten people attended offering a variety of skills for the project of giving the parish the best opportunities on two fields made available in the long term by the Duchy and Marsh Farm tenants, the Bests, for a community space. Survey for residents' comments commissioned. FIPL grant funds for 60 trees and fencing received for planting autumn/winter 2023/4. 2 Gateway to upper field cleared and opened up. Small working party started preparations for water supply to upper field. About 17 people came to walk the site and invited to comment. Direct access to lower field from road revealed. Enthusiastic support from neighbours Jenny and Simon Turnage, and Sandy. 3 2nd meeting received Terms of Reference, risk assessment, feedback and ideas. Clearance of sites to be progressed, surveys undertaken, design team to meet.

Advice from Natural Landscapes (AONB) to be sought, also visits to Grow Local, Metherell, and Deer Park Farm. 7. Tentative opening day 17 January 2024 (Wassailing Day).
