ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pivot/EdF Renewable Energy has been contacted (the only Battery Storage Project at Landulph that has NGET connection approval and therefore is free to move into construction phase) for a progress report. No response yet. • Cllr Ansell attended National Grid's 'Pathway to Net Zero' event in Exeter on 12th October. Key learnings: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ In GB there are currently more than 700 contracts with NGESO to collectively connect over 300GW of energy to the Grid! ○ But only 70 GW are actually required to meet GB's 2035 energy demand. ○ Many existing projects are considered speculative and unlikely to progress beyond local planning. ○ The application for connection process is considered as not fit for purpose and needs urgent reform. Government (DESNZ) and Regulator (OFGEM) are expected to provide guidance to National Grid in Q4 2023. ○ It is likely existing applications will be re-evaluated. • Confirmation that NGESO plan to join the Parish Council meeting in November (via MS Teams) to explain the purpose and benefits of the Grid Stability and Battery Storage developments at Landulph.
